### OUTERWEAR AND OTHER

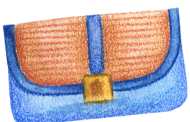
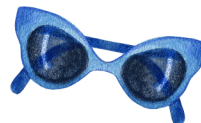
- Light jacket
